The RMC Foundation's Martha Vandervoort Memorial Scholarship is a wonderful resource for students. Scholarships can provide up to \$3,000 annually for college expenses to students who demonstrate community involvement, academic promise, good character, and financial need. Scholarships can be used for college expenses and tuition, and can be combined with other types of federal or college based financial aid.

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen and a resident of Calhoun County
- Applicant must be currently attending a public or private high school in Calhoun County
- Applicant must be accepted by an accredited college or university and persuing a degree in healthcare
- Applicant must have SAT or ACT scores available when applying
- Please encourage applicant to file a FAFSA as early as possible. To determine the level of financial need, the RMC Foundation will ask to see the Student Aid Report (SAR) from the FAFSA before an award can be confirmed.
- Completed applications are due by March 6, 2023

Students are asked to complete three brief essays to tell the Scholarship Committee about their future plans, their community involvement, and their financial need. A group of applicants will be selected mid-April for a follow-up interview, scheduled at the Regional Medical Center Foundation office. One student will be chosen from this group to receive the award.
